



The American Legion's Eagle Scout of the Year Award



The American Legion awards a \$10,000 national scholarship annually to its Eagle Scout of the Year. The three runners-up are each awarded \$2,500 scholarships. The Legion's Department of Maryland's winner gets a \$1,000 scholarship and his name and information are forwarded to the national scholarship competition.

The applicant must have received the Eagle Scout Award and the appropriate Boy Scout religious emblem awarded by his religious institution and must have demonstrated practical citizenship in church, school, Scouting, and the community.

The applicant also must be:

- the son or grandson of an American Legion, Sons of the American Legion or American Legion Auxiliary member, or
- he must be a member of a Scout Troop or Crew chartered to a Legion post, an Auxiliary unit, or a Sons of the American Legion squadron.

The applicant must reside in the Legion's department (state) to which he applies.
